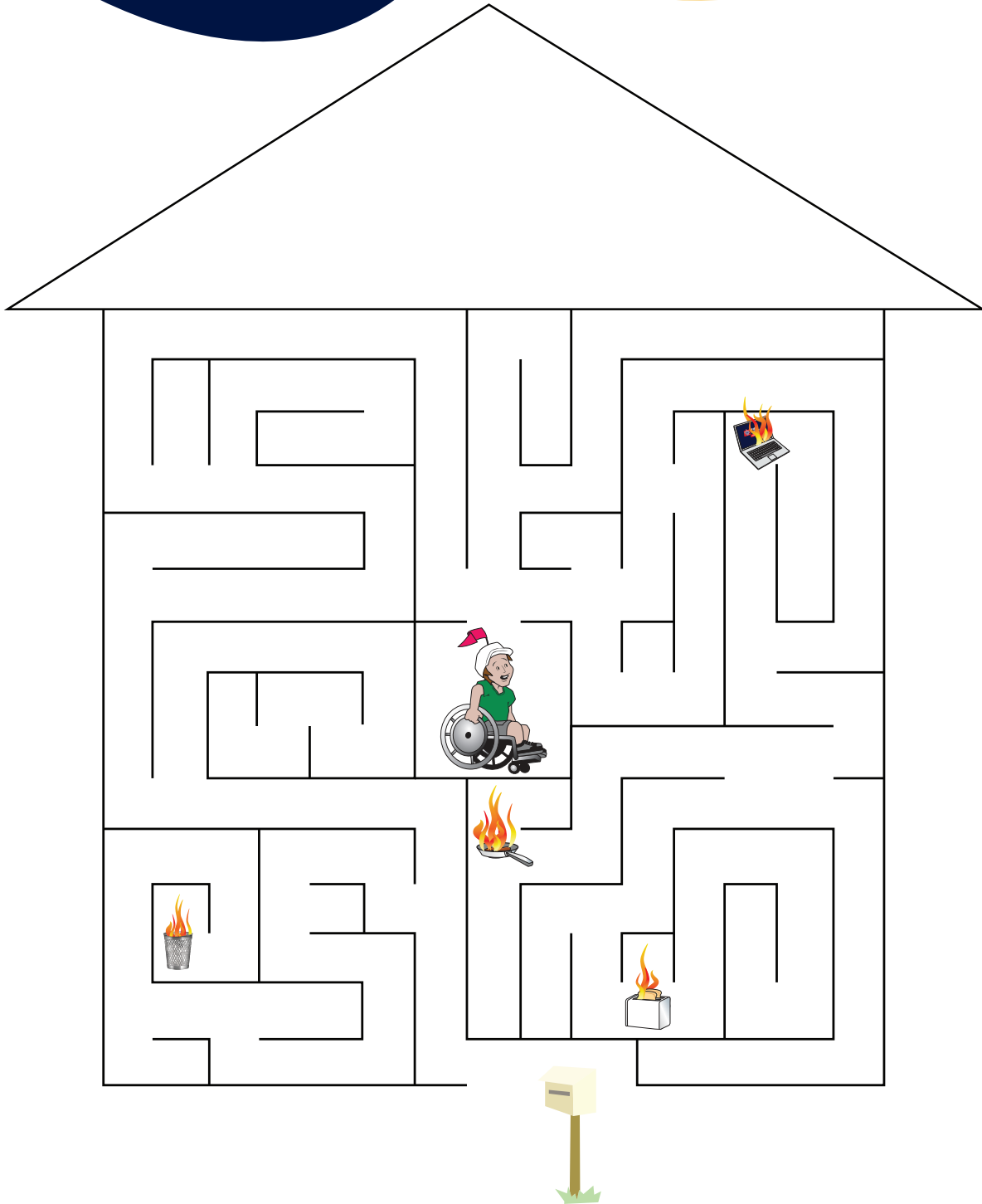


To get out of a smoky room you should crawl low under the smoke to the nearest safe exit. Keep going until you get outside. Go to your safe meeting place.

# FIREFIGHTERS IN ACTION!



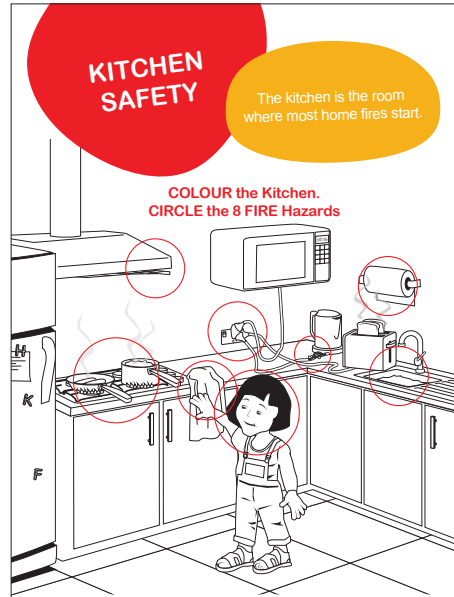
Firefighters will help you if there is an emergency. They will get there fast in the fire truck. You will hear the sirens and see the red and blue lights.
