





If there is a fire in your home a SMOKE ALARM will make a loud noise. Smoke alarms should be TESTED EVERY MONTH.


CRAWL DOWN LOW AND GO, GO, GO!

Help Zak find his way to the SAFE MEETING PLACE




Your safe meeting place should be away from traffic, away from smoke and fire and where the firefighters will see you when they arrive.
