Reporting period: 1 April 2022 to 30 June 2022

Primarily residential structure fires including commercial centres, industrial and/or community services e.g. schools, correctional facilities, hospitals. FRV has service delivery standards, which specify a response time target for a station to attend an emergency incident. The service delivery standard (response time) for Structure Fire is 7.7 minutes.
